



## BEHAVIOUR PROBLEMS

What steps can be followed to resolve a student's constant misbehaviour?

### TOP TIPS

1. If possible, meet with the student and describe in exact terms the behaviour you find unacceptable in the classroom.
2. During the discussion, explain the reason(s) why you find the behaviour unacceptable.
3. Be sure the student understands that it is not he/she who is unacceptable, but rather the behaviour.
4. Let the student know exactly what will happen if the problem continues.
5. If the misbehaviour occurs again, follow through with the previously planned disciplinary action.
6. Throughout the process, keep the parents and the Head informed of the progress or lack of progress.
7. If the student continues to misbehave and you feel that you have utilised all of your options and resources, send the student to the Head's office.
8. Explain to the student that he/she is welcome to return when he/she is ready to follow the classroom rules.
